IT'S BACK TO SCHOOL TIME

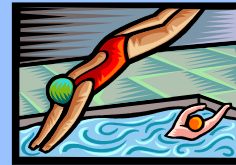
August 15, 2011 is the first 1/2-day back to school for Knox County and other schools.

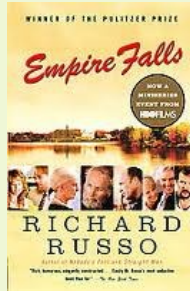
