### Thank You Volunteers!

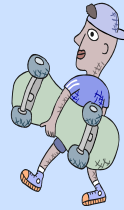
*Sugarwood has many wonderful volunteers that keep the neighborhood looking good. We'd like to thank them for all their help!*

#### **Recreation Area Maintenance**

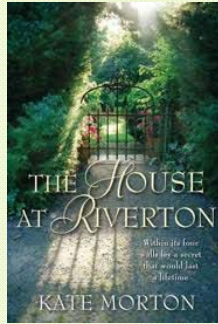
- ◆ New flood lights will be installed in the pool area.
