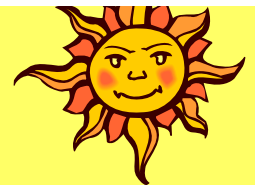

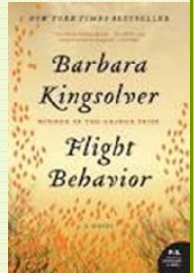

GO, STINGRAYS!

Did you notice all the cars and commotion down at the swimming area on Mondays and Thursdays in May? All those cars were bringing happy kids to work out in preparation for a great swim season which starts this month with over 150 'Rays in the water! The Sugarwood swim team is enjoying record growth this season- 36 new families so far! And a record 23 SHA member families!

June is a BIG MONTH for the big team! They start by warming up the water with an intersquad swim meet, travel for the first away meet of the season, then host three home meets in a row to round out the first month of summer swim competition.

June first's Red & Black Meet is a much-anticipated practice meet with a grand finale for everyone to enjoy. The 'Rays will gather Saturday morning at 8 am to kick off their season with team and individual photos in their new bright yellow team T-shirts. After the pictures are taken, the Rays take to the water- many for the first time as a competitive swimmer- for a mock meet where Rays good-naturedly swim against their fellow Rays as newcomers get a feel for how a swim meet goes. The end of the meet is a very exciting relay race which pits parent swimmers (many with gray hair under those swim caps!) and coaches against senior Ray swimmers. It's a great way to spend a Saturday morning- come on down! The Rays will have three days to recover before coming together to compete against View Harbor swim team at the View Harbor pool. The June 4 meet begins at 6 o'clock pm.

The following week, the Stingrays host the West Side Y Marlins, also at 6pm, on June 13. As with all home meets, drivers are asked to **NOT PARK ON THE STREET**. Volunteers will be directing traffic toward the field on the Northeast side of the pool for parking. The limited spaces in the regular parking lot will be limited to disabled and elderly guests. Orange cones will be placed along Butternut Circle as a reminder to respect residents by NOT parking in the street.

A short week later on Thursday, June 20th, another local YMCA- this time from the North- will visit the Sugarwood pool for a 6pm meet. Come cheer for your Stingrays!

On June 27th, the final home meet of the season will be held at the Sugarwood pool as the 'Rays take on the Gulfwood 'Gators. Midway through the meet the team will celebrate graduating 'Rays in their final season as they enjoy a final
