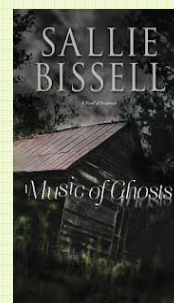

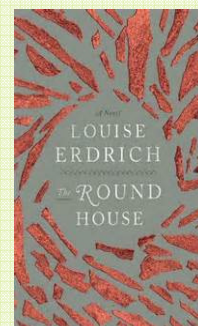
April 2014 Book Selection
