From the Stingrays

As March comes to a close and the calendar flips to April, the Sugarwood Stingrays swim team prepares for their 18th summer of swimming.

The 2017 summer highlights a season of change for the Stingrays. After a one-year stint in GKAISA League 1, the team returns to League 2. The 'Rays also welcome a new coaching staff, led by head coach Alison Carbaugh. "Sugarwood has been such an important part of my life for as long as I can remember, and I am thrilled that I get to carry on the Stingray spirit this year as the head coach," Carbaugh said in her greeting letter to the team.

The season is within view, which means there are some important dates to mark on your calendar. Returning swimmers and parents can sign up and meet the coaching staff at the Carbaugh Residence (12401 Butternut Circle) on Sunday, April 2 from 1-4 PM. New swimmers have early registration from 1-4 PM on April 23 and late registration on May 7, also from 1-4 PM. Both of these registration events will be located at the Sugarwood pool. If spaces still remain, there will be open registration from May 8 to May 31, but it is recommended that you sign up early. Is your child nervous about joining a swim team for the first time? That is not a problem-there are no requirements regarding swimming ability. The swimmer must be between the age of 5 and 18 to join the team. Coach Carbaugh has three maxims for the team: Have fun, improve as a swimmer, and compete (In that order!).

"I can't wait to see returning swimmers again and meet our newest additions to the team," Carbaugh said. "This is going to be a great season that no one is going to want to miss out on!"

Increasingly warmer spring weather is upon us so more people will be out and about walking, running, biking on the streets. There are more children playing outside. Please remember these very important safety tips:
