This summer has been a promising, yet challenging one for the Stingrays. For the first time in years, Sugarwood was promoted to League 1 competition, resulting in swim meets against the best teams in the area. While there have been some losses, there has also been a great amount of success by individuals and as a team. After dropping the first two meets of the year, the Stingrays bounced back with a narrow two-point victory on the road at Concord Hills! After finishing up the final two head-to-head meets, the Stingrays participated in the Smoky Mountain Invitational. This meet is comprised of all area teams, but only summer swimmers are permitted to swim events. Sugarwood delivered some excellent performances!

Among these standout performances were some resident Sugarwood swimmers! Grace La Charite swam to a FIRST PLACE finish in the 11-12 girls 100 yard Individual Medley-Congrats Grace! The Stingrays got another 1st place finish when the 11-12 boys Medley relay of Jackson Vineyard, Dallas Carbaugh, Jacob Phillips, and Pierce Vaught finished in a time of 2:22.48. Well done, boys! Westin Carbaugh also took home first place in the boys eight and under 50 yard freestyle. The 11-12 mixed freestyle relay of Jacob Phillips, Brooke Vaught, Dustin Chattan, and Grace La Charite also finished first overall!

The Stingrays hope to take this momentum into the GKISA city meet on July 29th -31st at the Allan Jones Aquatic Center.
