



Sugarwood Homeowners Association Annual Meeting Report

New Directors: Elected for two year terms were: Votes received in parentheses

John Rhodes (49) Blair Griffin (39) Jeff Papas (44) Angie Brown (34)

- The 2014 Budget was approved as presented to the membership. (66 for approval 0 against approval)
- ◆ The 2014 Homeowner fees were set at \$300.00 per year.(67 for approval 0 against approval)
- The reduction in lifeguard staff levels was approved. (42 for approval 9 against approval)
- A study committee to work with Farragut to reduce speeds in the neighborhood was established.
- The vote to install a key card security system for pool and tennis courts. (48 for approval and 3 against approval)
- The vote to develop a plan to construct a clubhouse at the recreational area for membership approval. (41 for approval and 6 against approval)


