Thank you to Blair Griffin, Ron Williams, Paul Hester and Jennie Hester for installing the lights, decorations and garland at the front entrance this year.

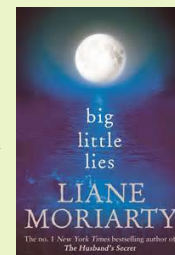
