

Bad news for all of our Sugarwood Walking Trail walkers. Due to the vandalism by a ATV during the recent rain the area of the trail that goes from the Virtue Road sidewalk behind the west side of the tennis court will be closed for repairs.

The area will have to be re-graded, seeded, and straw. Hopefully we can re-open that part of the trail late spring if all goes well. The mud on the pavilion and basketball court from the same incident should be cleaned off soon for future use. Our recreation area is for all current dues paying residents only. It is not to be used as a playground for ATV's, motorcycles, off road trucks, etc. Please respect all of our hard work to keep the area nice for what it was designed.
