Also, do not blow or dispose of yard waste in the storm sewer drains. The Town of Farragut indicates that this is not allowed.





- The lock at the tennis courts has been lost. The board will acquire a new lock and distribute the unlock code to residents interested in playing tennis.
- Concern has been expressed about residents blowing yard waste into the storm sewer drains. The Town of Farragut indicates that the storm sewer drains should not be used to dispose of yard waste.
- A second notice will be issued to residents who still have unpaid dues.


