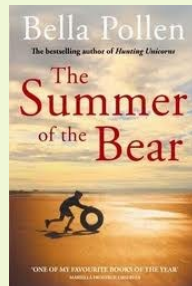

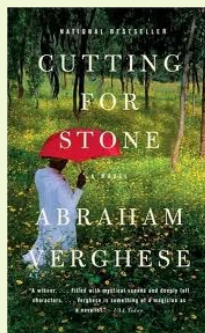
April 2012 Book Selection

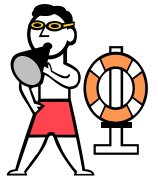
