Pool Rules Review—Proposed rules recommended for new board review.

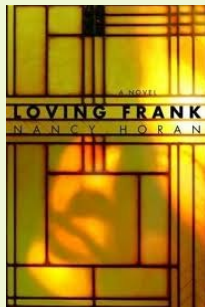

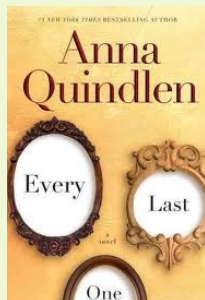
