Sugarwood has many wonderful volunteers that keep the neighborhood looking good. We'd like to thank them for all their help!


Many thanks to David & Alex Foster and Doug Draper for removing the downed tree limb at the entrance and hauling off the wood from behind the tennis courts.

Recreation Area Maintenance


- New flood lights will be installed in the pool area.


