## Neighborhood Safety Concerns



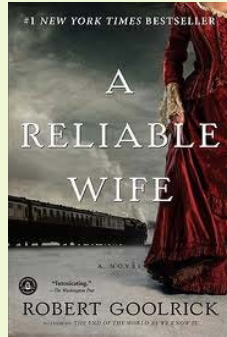

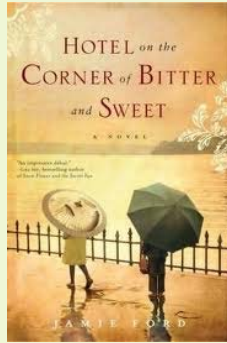
**Child Safety**—Please remind your young children that the neighborhood streets are NOT play areas. Children need to be careful when crossing the street.
