Dog Troubles

It was reported to the SHA Board that on January 31, 2011 at approximately 8:15 a.m. a person was bitten by a dog while walking on Broadwood. The dog is described as a large short-haired brindle lab-like dog with a heavy collar and tags. The dog ran snarling and growling at the walkers and then bit one of them on the leg. Due to the cold weather, the person had on extra padding that prevented the bite from breaking the skin. Police and animal control were notified, but could not do anything because the bite did not break the skin.

Neighborhood Walking Group





Sugarwood Book Club


February 2011 Book Selection:
